Emergency Plans

Ways to secure our group:

- ❑ Every person on the trip will be given a number to call out for attendance. This should allow us to take attendance in 30 seconds. Each chaperone will have rosters so they can quickly determine if someone is missing.
- ❑ Times we are in a public location (ie. In small towns, rest areas, or villages) students must stay with a chaperone, and in small groups. Interactions with native people, or any local people will be supervised by a chaperone.
- ❑ Locations we visit are all secluded. We will know where all students are located at all times.
